

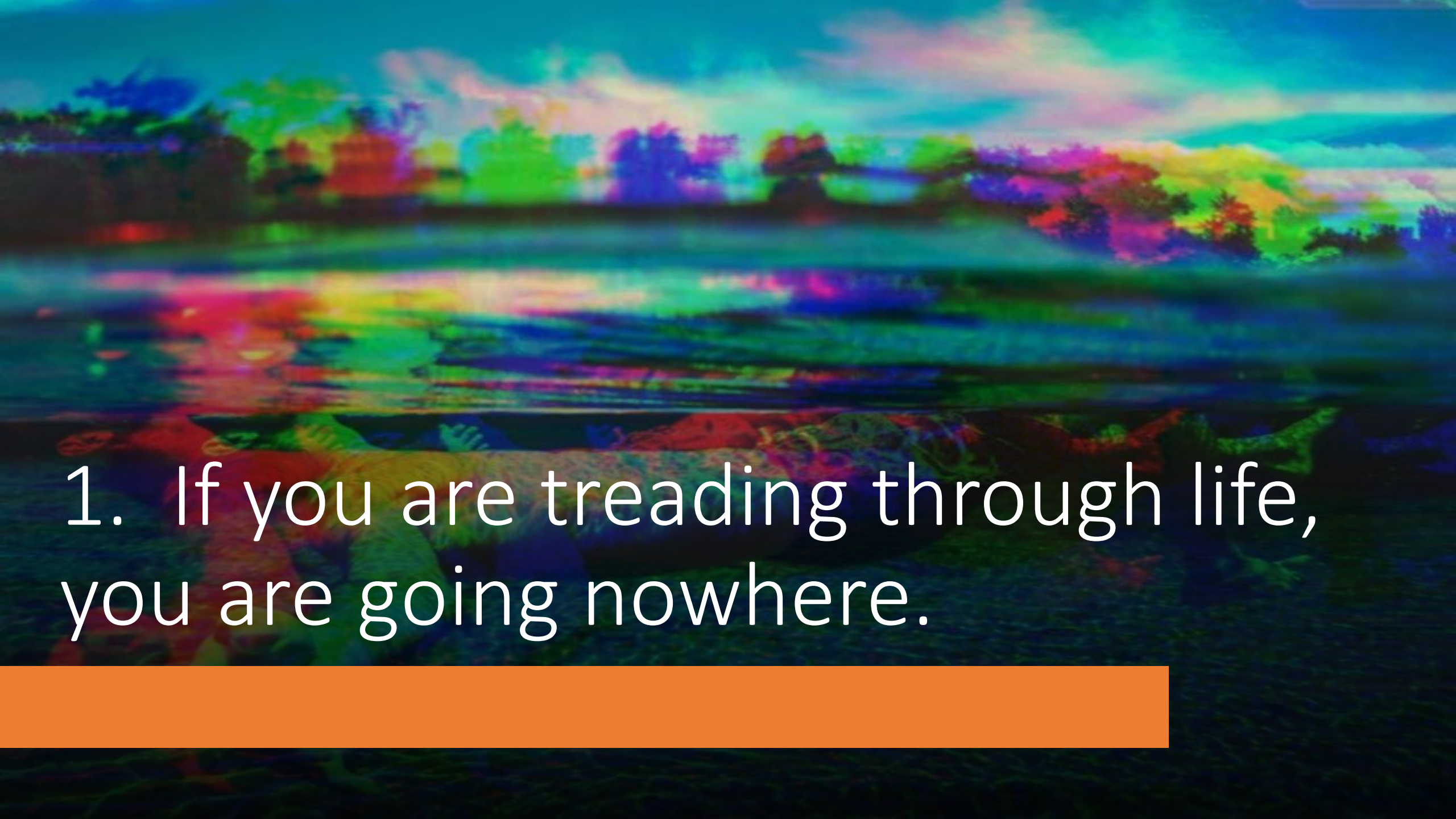


- II Samuel 9:6-8

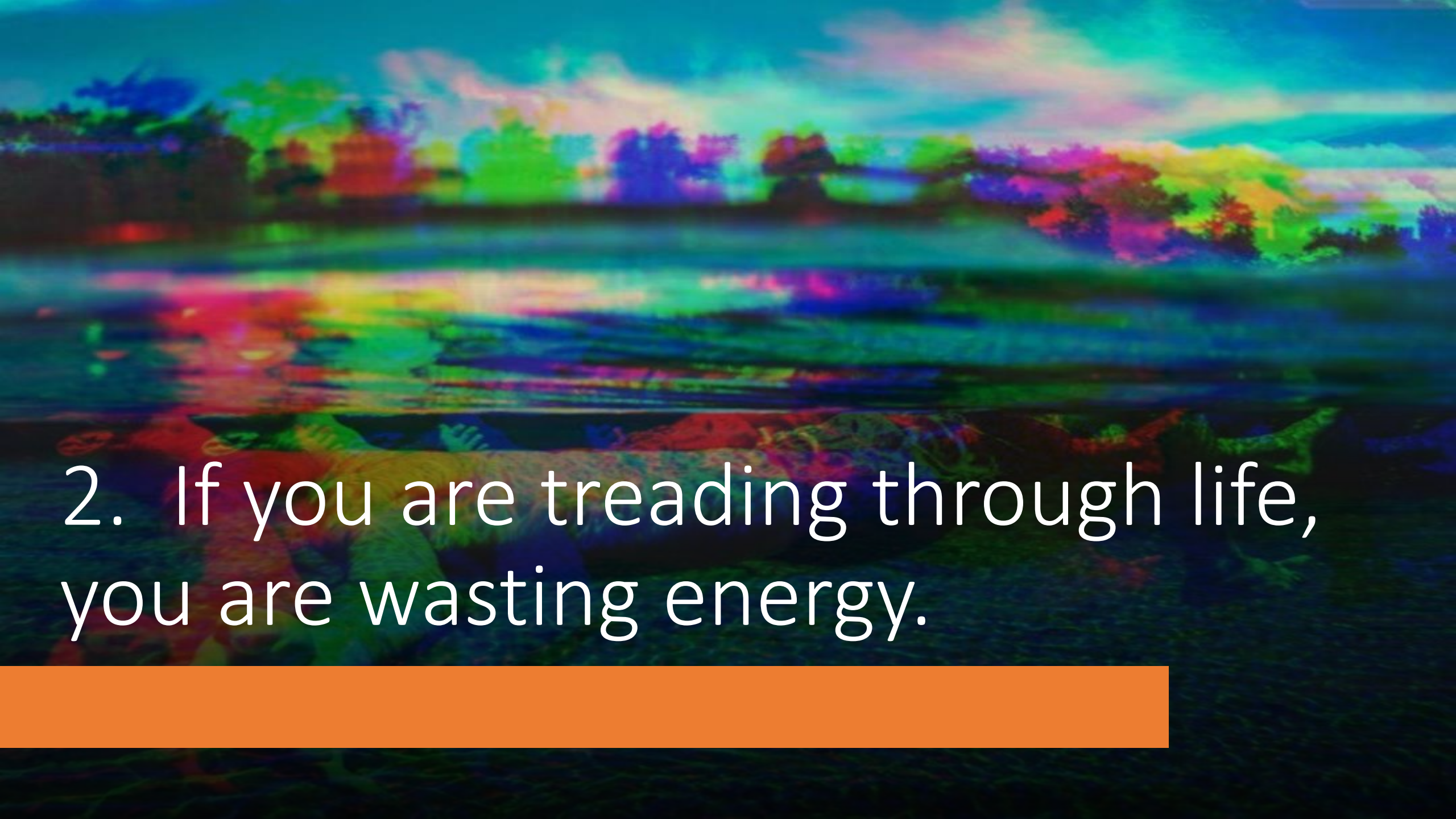


1. If you are treading through life,
you are going nowhere.



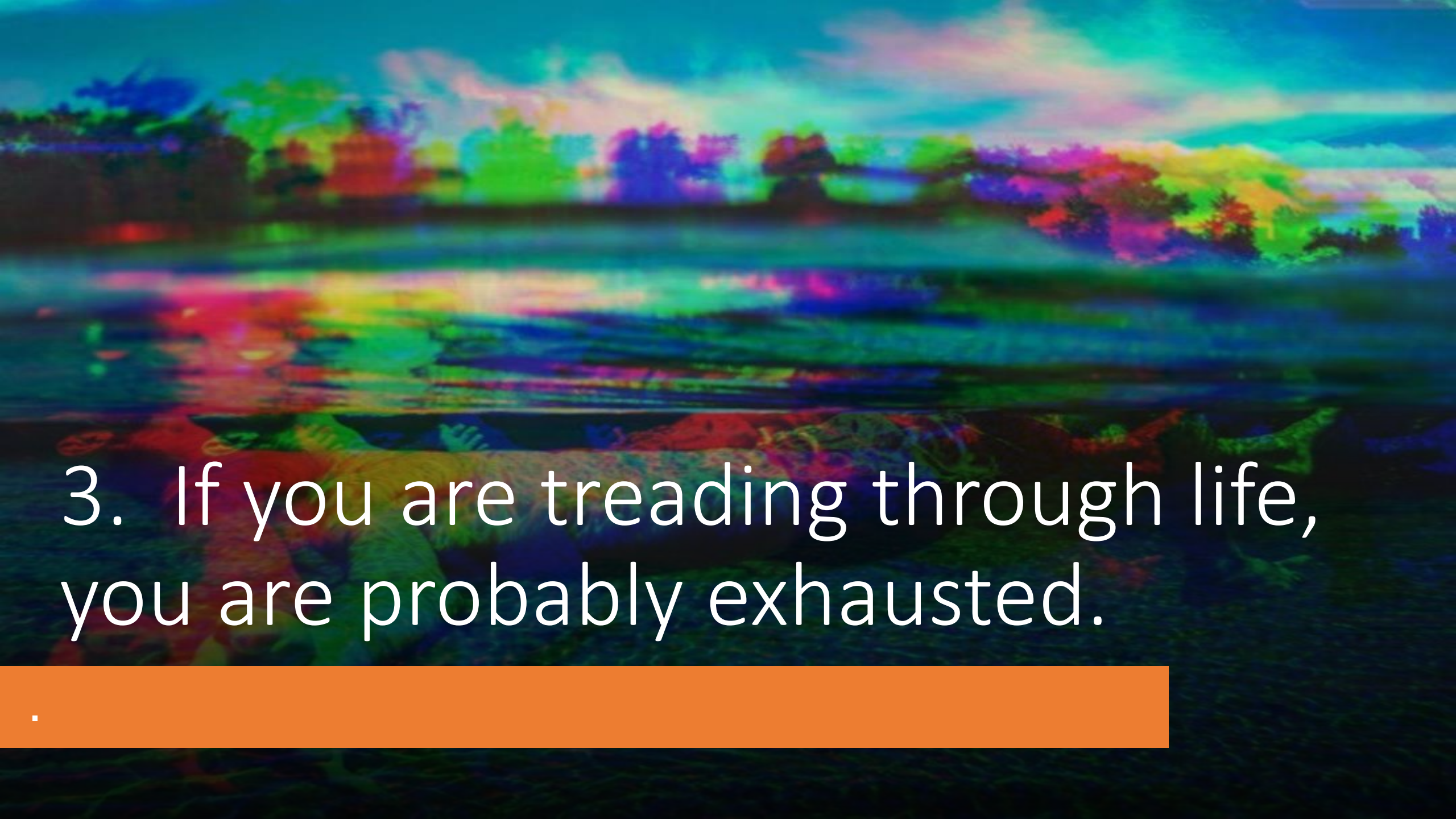
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- Treading may be necessary but only for a short season.
