- 1. to cause delay, interruption, or difficulty in; hamper; impede: The storm hindered our progress.
    - 2. to prevent from doing, acting, or happening; stop
    - 3. to be an obstacle or impediment.



1. Do not be **HINDERED** by the inconsistency of professing CHRISTIANS.

1 Peter 2:21 To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.

## 2. Do not be HINDERED by PERSECUTION, MISUNDERSTANDING or OPPPOSITION.

- I Peter 4:12-14 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:<sup>13</sup> But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.<sup>14</sup> If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified.

### 3. Do not be HINDERED by some severe Trial or Sorrow.

- John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

4. Do not be HINDERED by neglect of Fellowship with the LORD.

- John 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.



5. Do not be HINDERED by some willful act of DISOBEDIENCE.

- Jeremiah 26:13a Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and obey the voice of the LORD your God;





## 6. Do not be HINDERED by the pull of the WORLD.

- Matt 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
